What:

Goal of this group is to:

Where:

Rosedale Valley Ravine catchment area can extend from:

- a. West: Ramsden Park
- b. East: Riverdale Farm, the Brickworks, and island park across from the Castle Frank subway.
- c. North: the south side of South Rosedale
- d. South: a diagonal from the DVP, crossing Bloor Street, stretching up to and including Ramsden Park.

Why:

Things that were considered:

- a. Path
- b. Access points (e.g. new accesses, bike, disability)
- c. Greening of the Ravine
- d. Cataloguing of foliage and invasive species.
- e. List National historic sites (e.g. Group of 7 Studio).
- f. Places of interest (e.g. location of old brewery)
- g. Other Indigenous landmarks
